HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 65

**PROPOSED SHARED USE CYCLE TRACK
THE A205 KEW ROAD KEW BRIDGE, LONDON BOROUGH
OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES**

Transport for London wishes to notify the local community that it proposes to formalise the conversion of lengths of footway adjacent to the A205 Kew Road, Kew Bridge in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames to shared use cycle tracks.

The shared use cycle tracks will be on both sides of the footway of Kew Road from the Northern Junction with Kew Green and extend 363 metres north to the junction with Strand on the Green.

Shared use cycle tracks will be for cyclists and pedestrians where both will share the full width of the new cycle track, with each having equal rights over it. Signs and road markings will be used to mark the start and finish of the cycle track, and will make clear where the footway has been converted to a shared use cycle tracks.
