



Richmond Cycling Campaign response to consultation : A316 London Road Roundabout

We are very pleased to see a new toucan crossing in line with Cole Park Road. This is an important cycle route between Isleworth and Twickenham so a gratuitous detour was annoying.

We are also pleased with toucan crossings over the remaining arms of the roundabout. There is a long established cycle route alongside both sides of the A316 and crossing the ends of London Road was hazardous. We are pleased that the divergence from desire line has been minimised. Ideally we would have preferred single stage crossings for London Road even if that is not feasible for A316.

The remaining feature of concern is the narrowness of the shared pedestrian / cycling paths on the NW and SE sides of the roundabout made worse by an adjacent high brick wall. We note the remodelling of the central island – and would have liked to see the opportunity taken to widen these paths.
